What Information Do We Collect

There are two ways that we may collect information about you when you visit our site. *First*, when you access the Gilbert's LLP website, our site may exchange "cookies" with your browser program. A "cookie" is a bit of information that a website sends to your web browser, which contains technical information about you, such as the time of your last visit and the type of browser that you use.

Second, our website lists email addresses, and you may wish to contact us by electronic mail from time to time. You should keep in mind, however, that no Internet transmission is 100% secure or error-free, and that personal information contained in an email might be intercepted and read by a third party.
